
## **On-board notation**

Combined Trasport Document (shipment from a port)// Bill of Lading // Non-Negotiable Bill of Lading //Charter Party Bill of Lading



A dated on board notation is required

The date of issue is considered to be the date of shipment

An on board notation is also required where the ocean vessel and/or port of loading are stated to be "intended". In this event, the on board notation is to include the name of the vessel and/or the port of loading.

Where the port of loading stated in the credit is shown as the place of receipt (the ocean vessel and port of loading fields, in this case, are reflecting the transhipment details) with shipment by sea from that port, a dated on board notation is required evidencing the port of loading stated in the credit and the vessel that is leaving that port.
